Newsletter - The spring newsletter is being finalized. The group discussed an article about Miss Lizzie. There was concern raised that quotes in the article could cause emotional distress for some. Tom will rewrite the article.

USPS Mailing/Fundraising - Briefly discussed the pros/cons of sending fundraising letters via USPS.

Visits to other Historical Societies were discussed. Deer Isle and Castine would be easier than trying to coordinate with one of the other islands. There was some interest from the Great Cranberry Historical Society about visiting IAH again. This would be coordinated with the church as well.
