1. Approval of Treasurer's Warrant #13 \$19,844.91 3-0
2. Approval of School Warrant #2 \$3,775.15 3-0
3. Approval of payroll 07/22/26 \$7,329.15 3-0
4. Approval of previous minutes 07/08/26 3-0
5. Motion to go into executive session at 4:59 P.M. to protect the character and anonymity of a community member, seconded and approved 3-0. Executive session ended at 5:10 P.M.
6. The town's audit has been completed and has been approved, with commendation from the auditor.
7. The selectboard has been in contact with the Maine CDC regarding proper documentation of a dog bite incident involving a human, all documentation and communication has been handled properly by the municipality.
8. SWCA, hired by the consortium of Blue Hill Towns, surveyed 18 homes for wildfire risk as a part of the island wide wildfire preparedness plan that is being created for the Town. This project is funded by a grant received by Island Institute.
9. The board has received notice that the comprehensive plan has been passed through review after minor revisions and has been accepted by the state. A special meeting for the town to approve the plan will be scheduled at a time in the early fall TBD.
10. Vote to move forward with the Coastal Communities Grant, provided by the Maine Office of Community Affairs to procure funding for the engineering of the roadside/shore bluff across from the church boardwalk for erosion protection, moved and approved 3-0. The selectboard is also exploring funding options for the construction work identified by the engineering survey.
11. The selectboard received a loose inquiry and a formal inquiry about renting the Head Harbor School House. We are in communication with the interested parties, and we are working toward completing renovations before accepting a new tenant.
12. A representative from the county office for General Assistance is going to do a site visit for the town hall in September to ensure all required notices are properly posted.
